Cinema Education – The Festival's Educational Program Featuring Workshops, Screenings, and Filmmaker Talks *Date of publication: May 2, 2025*

The AmiCorti International Film Festival reaffirms its commitment to younger generations with the return of Cinema Education, a special program dedicated to students, teachers, and young filmmakers, now in its 7th edition.

From June 23 to 28, 2025, in Roccaraso (AQ), Italy, the festival will present a comprehensive calendar of activities aimed at bringing young audiences closer to the language of cinema as a tool for critical reflection, creativity, and active citizenship.

The program includes:

Morning Educational Screenings

A curated selection of short films and documentaries addressing timely topics such as **inclusion**, **the environment**, **human rights**, **and identity**, followed by guided discussions with experts and tutors.

Participatory Filmmaking Workshops

Hands-on labs led by international directors and educators, where students will explore all stages of audiovisual creation: from writing and directing to sound and editing.

Filmmaker Talks

Open dialogue sessions with guest directors who will share behind-the-scenes insights into their films and discuss the social impact of their work.



International Exchange and Cultural Dialogue

The program brings together Italian schools and international students, creating a multicultural space for learning and creative exchange.

Project Objective

To equip young participants with critical tools, promote independent thinking, and encourage engagement through the power of cinema.

The **Cinema Education program is free of charge**, and all participants will receive an official **certificate of participation**.
